Position overview:

The Vocation Director is responsible for promoting a “culture of vocation” among the Presentation Sisters, the Friends of Nano lay movement and all people of good will. The Vocation Director will accompany women in the discernment of their life choices with emphasis on the Presentation way of life.

Accountable to: Unit Leader or her delegate

Key Responsibilities:

- Organizing and coordinating vocation promotion activities/events throughout the Unit and beyond and evaluating their effectiveness
- Leading and animating Presentation Sisters to engage in vocation promotion
- Sharing the spirituality, charism and mission of the Presentation Sisters
- Engaging with and participating in events that gather young adults
- Being an inviting presence to young adults
- Accompanying women in their vocation discernment
- Providing prayer and discernment opportunities for women and arranging hospitality with local communities of Presentation Sisters for interested women
- Maintaining accurate and confidential files of contacts, enquirers, and discerners
- Preparing and updating vocation promotion materials, e.g., print, social media, website, VISION Vocation Network
- Participating in the Congregational Vocation Animation Conferences and other ongoing professional development in vocation ministry, e.g., NRVC (local, regional, national)
- Preparing an annual budget and regular reports
- Other related duties as assigned

- * Familiarity with the spirituality, charism and mission of the Presentation Sisters
- * Enthusiasm for and understanding of religious life
- * A degree and/or experience in a field relevant to the position (e.g., religious education, applied theology, marketing, pastoral ministry, counseling)
- * Self-awareness with a commitment to personal faith and spiritual growth
- * Capacity to animate, engage and empower individuals and groups
- * Organizational skills
- * Effective English communication skills (written, verbal, digital); bilingual is a plus
- * Ability to collaborate
